

2021 Wood Stove Exchange Program



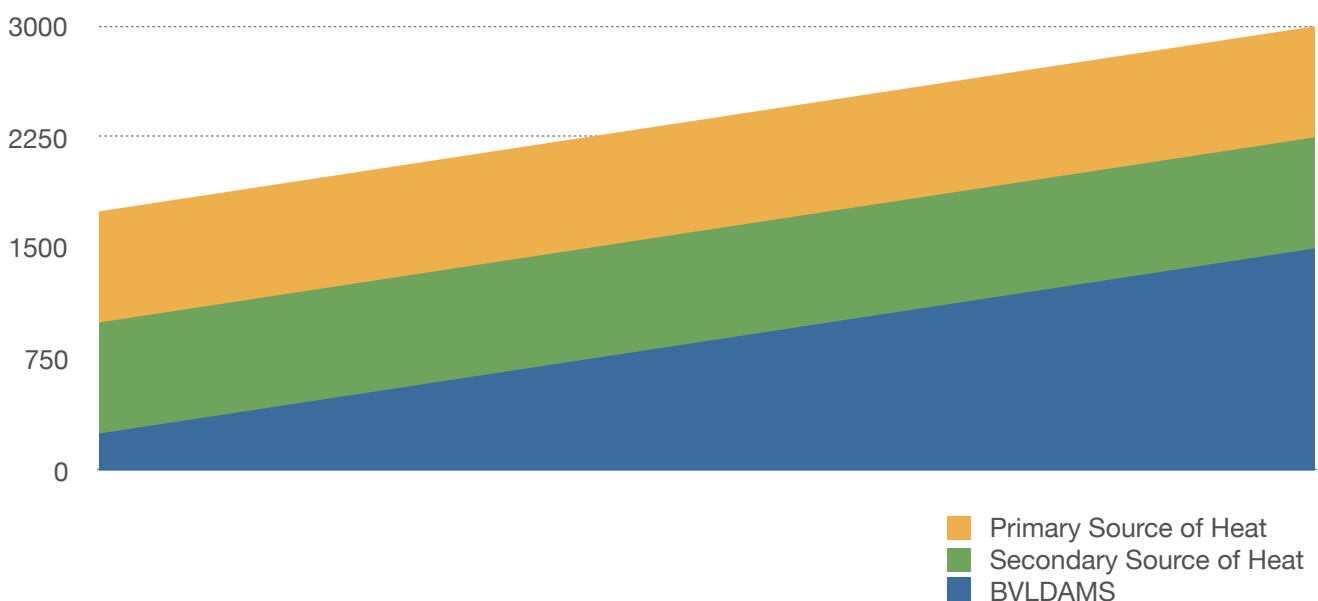
The Bulkley Valley Lakes District Airshed Management Society (BVLDA AMS) wants you to be warm, healthy and efficient heating your home always! Make an informed choice seasoning your wood, installing, maintaining and repairing your home heating appliances.

If you live in the **Town of Smithers** there are 2 additional rebate amounts. That means you get the rebate you qualify for based on your choices from our society PLUS you get an additional amount based on whether your appliances is listed as your secondary heating appliance or primary.

Since there are a range of rebate amounts available your cash back could be as low as \$750 or as high as \$3000.00.

Stacked Savings



Some Conditions apply:

1. Old appliances must be non current EPA certified.
2. Old units must be recycled or decommissioned.
3. Proof must be provided for the recycling and installation.
4. Rebate values depend on appliance types chosen and recycled.
5. Refund program lasts while funding permits.
6. Installations use WETT principles and follow Provincial or Municipal building and other regulations.
7. The Wood Stove Exchange Rebate Form is complete and pics are provided.
8. Secondary heating appliances are defined as those appliances that are most used in the house.
9. Primary heating appliances are defined as those listed as the Primary source of heat by the Insurance Company.
10. Only 1 rebate per household.

Other appliances that can be changed out:

free-standing "stove", "homemade" or 'barrel'
oil furnace
open masonry fireplace
piped-propane furnace, stove
tube type heat exchanger with a face plate and door (usually installed in an open fireplace)

Did you know...

- the Building Permit Fee is waived in Smithers, value \$35
- building inspections are no longer necessary if the appliance is Wood Energy Tech. Training, WETT inspected
- the Bulkley Valley Credit Union, BVCU still has zero interest loans for purchasing EPA certified appliances
- there are no landfill or recycling depot fees at any location
- the BVLDAMS is a non profit society, responsible for implementing the Clean Air Plan of 2012 signed by Bulkley Valley and Lakes District stakeholders in clean air. Membership is free!
