



Recycling Cart Instructions

Please put only the following listed materials into the recycling collection container:

ALL PAPER	CONTAINERS	METAL	PLASTICS
<p>Newspapers, inserts, flyers, catalogues, magazines, telephone books</p> <p>Household paper, paper gift wrap, greeting cards</p> <p>Corrugated cardboard</p> <p>Boxboard boxes ie. cereal, crackers</p> <p>Moulded boxboard ie. egg cartons, beverage carry out trays</p> <p>Paper bags that have single and multiple paper layers, ie. pet food bags</p> <p>Shredded paper (in firmly tied clear plastic bag)</p>	<p>Paper beverage cups, aseptic boxes and cartons ie. soups, sauces</p> <p>Frozen dessert boxes ie. ice cream</p> <p>Milk cartons</p> <p>Microwavable bowls and cups</p> <p>Spiral wound paper cans and metal lids</p>	<p>Metal cans and lids</p> <p>Aluminum foil wrap</p> <p>Aluminum take-out containers</p> <p>Aluminum baking containers</p> <p>Aerosol cans and caps</p>	<p>Plastic bottles, jugs and jars with caps and lids</p> <p>Plastic clamshells ie. for baked goods, fruit, eggs, trays and tops, tubs and lids</p> <p>Plastic cold drink cups and lids</p> <p>Plastic garden plant pots and seedling trays</p> <p>Plastic pails ie. for laundry detergent, ice cream, must be less than 25L</p>
<p><i>Please remember that all materials must be loose (not bagged), excluding shredded paper. Please empty and rinse containers.</i></p> <p>See www.smithers.ca for additional recycling information.</p>			

DO NOT put the following materials into the recycling collection cart:

- Plastic Bags & Overwrap - Styrofoam - Plastic Foam Containers, Trays for Food & Cushion Packaging - Glass Bottles
- Glass Jars - Wood - Food Waste - Compost - Liquids - Fabrics - Books (hard cover or paper back)
