



COVID 19 ARENA USE PROCEDURES

General Information

- All participants must abide by all Federal, Provincial, Municipal, and Organizational COVID-19 safety plans / orders.
- Physical Distancing 2 metres (6 feet), Cleaning & Sanitation, Signage, Outbreak Mitigation Recovery

Entrance Rules

- User groups will follow signage for entrance and exit of the facility.
- Facility access for participants is limited to 10 minutes prior to the rental time – please be on time.
- All rental groups are required to have a COVID Ambassador to assist with facility access and managing occupancy limits and to ensure their cohort follows all applicable protocols.
- Facility users will not be allowed in the building until their COVID ambassador has arrived.
- Arena staff will only open doors for ambassador.
- 45 minutes is allocated to clean and flood the ice and to conduct a COVID touch point cleaning of the facility between each ice booking cohort. No public will be admitted during the allotted cleaning time.
- Doors must remain locked at all times.
- Lobby Occupancy is 16 participants.

Change Area Rules

- Participants must come dressed in full gear and bring a full water bottle.
- Bags are permitted in designated area. No dressing/undressing inside arena.
- Dressing Rooms are closed.
- Players must sit in designated marked seating locations to change from street shoes to skates.
- Skate guards, street shoes, and bags must be left at designated seating location as the participants take the ice.
- All participants must leave arena as fully dressed as possible – changing into street clothes is not permitted.
- All participants must vacate the facility 10 minutes after rental so that areas of the facility can prepped, cleaned, and disinfected prior to the next group entering the building.

On Ice Rules

- There is a maximum of 20 participants plus up to 5 coaches permitted on the ice surface.
- Social distancing of at least 2 meters between players must be adhered to at all times.
- Drills must be designed with provincial guidelines in place.
- Socially Distanced Play is permitted under the regulations available from the Recreation Department.
- Participants and Coaches must keep gloves and equipment on at all times. No touching of pucks with hands by players. Coaches must pick up pucks at end of the session.
- No sharing of equipment.
- Players and coaches can use the player's benches while maintaining social distancing.
- Participants must place water bottles on the top rail at bench.
- At the end of the session, participants must exit the ice on time so that the next group can start on time.

Miscellaneous Rules

- No spitting anywhere inside the facility or on the ice.
- **Sanitization of the arena spaces will only occur periodically. Please wash your hands.**
