In these cases ESP will match the EGH grant up to a combined maximum of \$1500. ESP provincial grant applies to all qualified incentive upgrades including high efficiency furnaces with the exception of mid-efficiency furnaces. 2. EnerPac contains energy saving products like compact fluorescent lighting and low flow showerheads. 3. Available in service areas only. 4. BC Hydro Power Smart rebate based on \$1/sq. foot for Energy Star qualified windows. 5. Incentive amount is subject to available funding and can be modified at any time. ESP and Terasen incentives are in market until December 31, 2006.

Additional Energy Savings Plan Programs

Low-Income Buildings – High Energy Savings

The ESP team is working to bring social, economic and environmental benefits of energy efficiency to low-income buildings.

Multiple Savings for Multi-Unit Residential Buildings

Financial incentives are available for strata councils of a limited number of multi-unit, low-rise residential buildings. These incentives will be awarded on a first come, first served basis so we recommend early inquiries. Participating ESP communities include City of Vancouver, City of North Vancouver, Central Saanich, Fort St. John and Oliver.

Small Commercial Program – Big Energy Savings

Financial incentives are available for a limited number of small commercial/industrial/institutional buildings. Participating ESP communities include City of Victoria, Central Saanich, Fort St. John and Oliver.
