The Smithers Regional Airport, located 5 km northwest of the Town of Smithers, occupies approximately 340 hectares of land adjacent to the north side of Yellowhead Highway 16. The Smithers Regional Airport is part of a regional air system that links domestic and international services. It is also the furthest North registered Airport with scheduled commercial passenger and charter flights.

The airport land represents a unique development opportunity for future airport related activities due to its proximity to regional markets and unique airside, road and rail links, including Yellowhead Highway 16.

The Smithers advantage includes affordable lease rates, diversified local economy, low cost of living, access to affordable housing, world class recreation and tourism opportunities and government services.


