Smither Regional Airport Lands Environmental Investigation – Request for Quote

1.0 INTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND

The Town of Smithers (ToS) owns and operates the Smithers Regional Airport (SRA), a public airport with scheduled commercial services and charter flights, located 5 km northwest of the ToS (the Site). The SRA occupies approximately 340 hectares and these lands represent a significant opportunity for economic development and diversification for the airport operations and regional economy. The SRA was recently awarded a grant to assist with environmental investigation and remediation to prepare several areas for future development.

The SRA is currently seeking qualified local contractors to provide services throughout 2024. Activities may include drilling of boreholes up to a depth of 75m, installation of 2" monitoring wells and the installation of soil vapour probes. To complete this work, the ToS is requesting availability, rates, and information for the following:

- Drilling equipment capable of:
 - Drilling a borehole of 6" in diameter
 - Provide continuous soil samples throughout drilling in either bags or split spoons, or other
- Monitoring well and soil vapour probe installation

As part of the quotation include where equipment and staff are located, as well as any affiliations with local First Nations. For budgeting purposes, please provide a quote to drill and install 3 monitoring wells at the SRA including the collection of soil samples every 1.5m throughout drilling. The quotation is to be sent to rblackburn@smithers.ca or airportadmin@smithers.ca and is due by 5:00pm Pacific Standard Time on May 29th, 2024.
